

Voluntary Health Insurance for Students

Hi.

If you're reading this, it means that **you do not currently have NFZ Insurance, a EHIC Card or Karta Polaka**. Let's start with explaining the benefits of "voluntary health insurance". Voluntary health insurance is a type of insurance that you can buy directly in a NFZ facility. It allows you to use the services of NFZ medical facilities for free.

The insurance costs 55,80 zł per month.

You might be wondering **"How can I get this insurance?"**

Don't worry, I will guide you.



Step 2.



When you have prepared everything, go to your **nearest NFZ branch***. There you will be able to submit your documents. The staff working in this facility will explain how to pay for the insurance.

Step 3.



Upon your first payment, you are all set and are insured with Voluntary Health Insurance (NFZ Insurance)!

Now just keep in mind that if you need a GP doctor appointment you can sign up with Centermed using the declaration form that can be found at our clinics. When you need us, we will be ready!

Step 1.

You need to prepare and collect:



Print and complete 2 copies of the **NFZ Health Insurance Coverage application**



Passport



Valid student card or a certificate that proves you are a student issued by the university



A document confirming residence in Poland (If you live in a dormitory, you will need the certificate of living in the dormitory. If you live in an apartment, you will need a copy of your residential lease agreement.)

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
